



Background Map

You can change between different backgrounds of the map display. Active content selected in the Layers Tab remains the same when you change a background



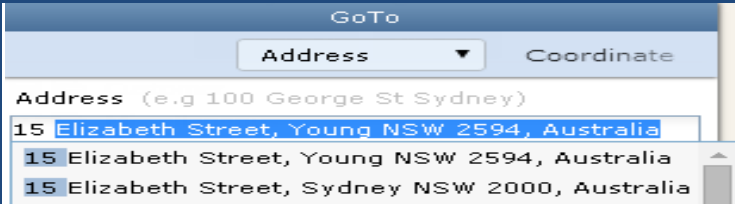
Map Navigation

Tools allow you to fit the whole map, zoom in/out, and pan around the map. Also contains tools to identify layers in the map, activate Google Street View, share a map via web link and book mark a map.



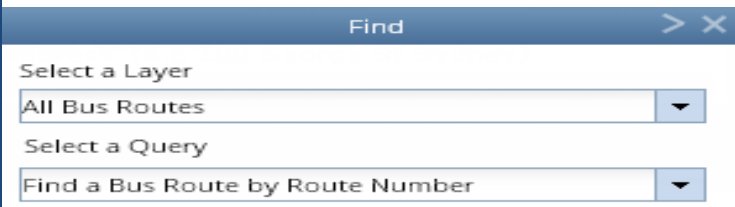
Content

This allows users view various **Layers** of Geographic Information such as bus networks or cycle networks against various maps and aerial imagery. Related layers are grouped together. Both groups and individual layers can be turned on/off by clicking the tick box. If a layer name is in *grey Italics* it is not visible at that zoom extent. The **Legend** button also shows symbology styles so you can identify information items in the map.



GoTo

Allows you to zoom to a location such as a **Town, Local Government Area, Suburb, Postcode or Address**. Note you must be connected to the internet for the Google Address Locator to work. Type at least the first three characters of the location you wish to find, press enter and list of options will appear as dropdown list. Clicking the appropriate location from the list will zoom map to that location.



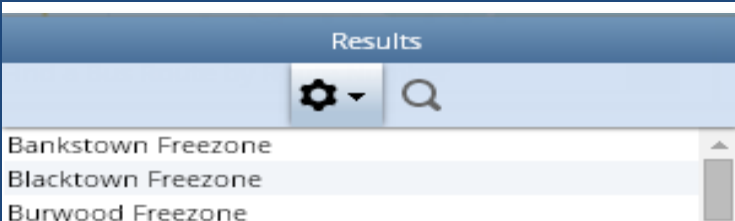
Find

Allows you to perform predefined queries for a particular layer. Choose a layer to query and a query type (note, a layer may have several different query types available). Enter a value to query and click the **Query** button. The query will be performed and results displayed in the **Results** tab. Click the **Clear** button to clear the current query and perform another query.



Select

This allows users to select features from a layer using five tools (**Point, Radial circle, Line, Rectangle, Polygon**). Selected items will be displayed in the Results.



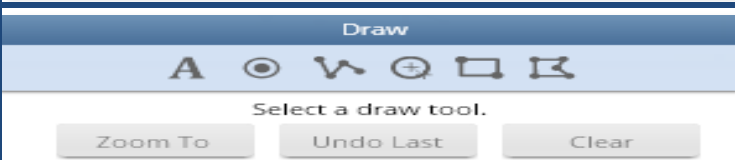
Results

Lists results from the Select or Find tabs. Hovering your mouse over a result record will highlight that record in the map. Clicking a result record will zoom to that record in the map. Click the Highlight All button to highlight all selected records. Click the Zoom To button to zoom to all selected records. Click the Clear button to clear the results from the results list. Click the Detailed Results button view feature attributes and to export out results to Excel.



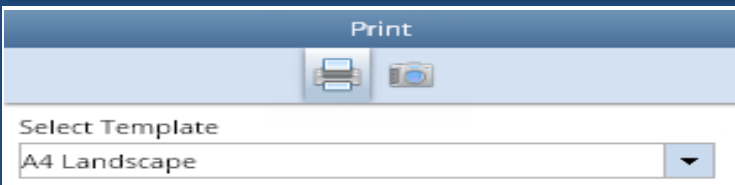
Measure

Allows you to measure either a line or an area on the map and acquire coordinates of a feature. Select a tool type from the top of the widget **Dropper, Line or Polygon**. Single click on the map to start measuring. Double click to finish measuring. Results are displayed and totalled at the bottom of the Measure widget. Units of measurement can be changed. Coordinates can be viewed by selecting the **Dropper** and clicking on a point of interest, coordinates are displayed in the window. Click the **Clear** button to reset and start measuring again.



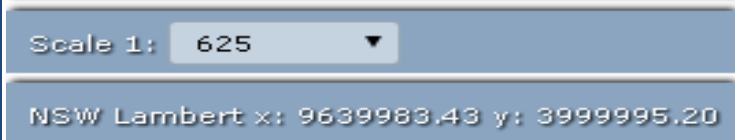
Draw

Draw allows you to mark up a map. Choose to draw either text, a point, a line, a circle, a rectangle or a polygon and select options for drawing style. Mark ups can be printed but are not saved if you refresh the Transportal application. Click the Undo Last or Clear All button to remove mark up from the map.



Print

Creates a printed map of the current view extents. You can create a Print using predefined templates A4/A3 (Landscape or Portrait) or create a snapshot of a specific area using a rectangular selection tool. Click the Print button so that print is available to download from print history. Multiple prints can be generated under print history. Click on 'clear print history' link to delete all the generated prints.



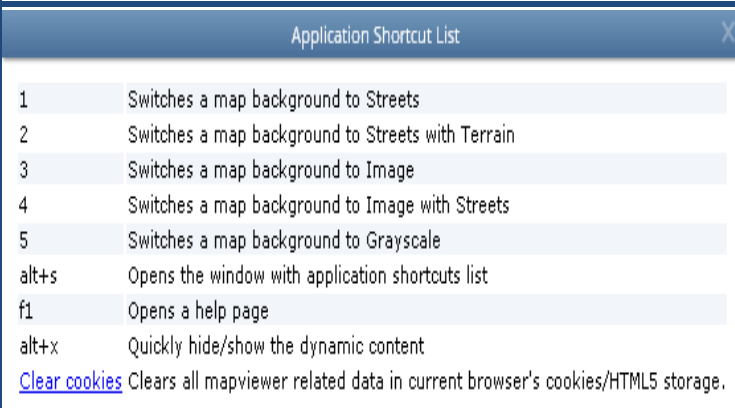
Current Scale and Coordinate Readout

Shows the current zoom scale of the map (between 1:625 to 1:5,500,000) and the co-ordinates of the cursor location in NSW Lamberts GDA94 co-ordinate system.



Theme Switch

Themes provide different content and functions dependent on the topic of the Theme. Some Themes are targeted towards specific business functions. Clicking on 'Theme Switch' will provide the list of available themes to navigate. Selection of any theme appearing under the dropdown list of 'Theme Switch' will reload the application with the selected theme. Some themes may be secure and require a password.



Application Shortcut List

Pressing the keys Alt + S will display the shortcut list for few operations. These keyboard operations are alternative to the mouse click operations. Clicking on the 'Clear cookies' hyper link appearing under the shortcut list will clear the cache in order to improve the application performance.
